

# ***COPS Quick Facts***

## **For the 5th District of Maryland**

To Date, \$59,570,462 in COPS grants were awarded to law enforcement agencies in the 5th District of Maryland

### **Highlights**

- COPS grants have funded 908 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in the 5th District.
- 18 local and state law enforcement agencies in the 5th District have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$7,770,758 has been awarded to add 63 school resources officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout the 5th District.
- \$18,836,656 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of the 5th District of Maryland fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
