The telephone town hall operates much like a large-scale conference call between Rep. Hoyer and citizens living in Maryland's Fifth Congressional District. Before the town hall begins, thousands of households will receive a direct call from Rep. Hoyer inviting them to join him for the town hall. Call recipients have the option of staying on the line to hear opening remarks from Rep. Hoyer, followed by a question and answer session. Rep. Hoyer's previous town hall meetings have drawn as many as 3,800 participants.
