North Point High School located at 2500 Davis Road, Waldorf, MD. The town hall will provide 5th

District citizens an opportunity to discuss the goals and details of efforts to reform health care, learn how they will benefit from improvements to the system, and voice their views and questions to the Congressman.

"As Congress considers legislation to provide greater health care stability for all Americans, I believe that an open and thorough discussion, including the experiences and views of my constituents, is critical," stated Rep. Hoyer. "Health care has been a topic of debate at the kitchen tables of American citizens for decades, and one that I have focused on in every year I have served in office. I look forward to continuing the discussion in this next town hall meeting and hope citizens will join me for this important conversation."
