
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Fishing Creek, MD Dredging and Jetty Repair Project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the United States Army Corps of Engineers, located at 2 Hopkins Plaza, Baltimore, MD 21201. The funding would be used to appropriately manage the assets around Fishing Creek, MD. Work activities could include but are not limited to south jetty repair, channel maintenance and environmental restoration. The project is located at Chesapeake Beach, Calvert County, Maryland, on the western shore of the Chesapeake Bay. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the community in and around Chesapeake Beach need a functioning channel and jetty. The lack of a working jetty has led to economic harm to local businesses and marinas. The community recreating around the area in public waters are put at a safety risk. The ecosystem is not as resilient as it could be. This project will improve coastal resilience, structural integrity, and economic outcomes for the community.

The project has a federal nexus because the Fishing Creek project authorized by the River and Harbor Act of 1937.
