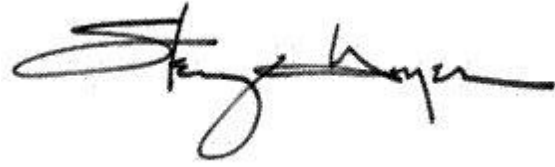
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the Town of La Plata - Southwest Access Management Plan project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of La Plata, located at 350 Queen Anne Street, La Plata, MD 20646. The funding would be used to execute an access management and safety plan for US 301 south of Charles Street (MD 6). The project will make changes to neighborhood access points, support new development projects, address mounting traffic congestion, reduce the risk of serious injuries and fatalities, and improve response time and travel time to and from Charles Regional Medical Center. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it addresses multiple road safety and operational problems along US 301 on the south side of La Plata, which has seen extraordinary residential growth in the past five years. The project is a follow-on to a feasibility study performed by the Town in 2023, and further design development currently being funded by a Safe Streets for All Planning/Demonstration Program grant. The improvements combine several low-cost approaches to addressing safety and operational concerns.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 23 USC 133.
