
Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding for the MedStar Ambulatory Services and Rural Healthcare Improvement project in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is MedStar Ambulatory Services, located at 10980 Grantchester Way, Columbia, MD 21044. The funding would be used for renovations at MedStar Health Urgent Care at La Plata to support the addition of onsite Orthopedic services, including updates to existing clinical areas, creation of three exam rooms and an Orthopedic workroom, and improvements to waiting and reception spaces to support patient flow and comfort. It would also include renovations at four high-volume sites: Charlotte Hall, Shopper's World, Great Mills, and California. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the project will help upgrade critical healthcare facilities for rural and semi-rural populations within the district, frequently functioning as the most convenient and realistic source of care for working families, seniors, and military connected residents.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized under the Public Health Service Act.
